Dear Parents:

As you may know, your child's school plans to participate in TV-Turnoff Week 2007, April 23-29, together with thousands of other schools and communities nationwide. We encourage your whole family to participate in this experiment by leaving your television set(s) off for the entire week.

TV-Turnoff Week is about taking a healthy break from TV and all media to focus on activities that are more academically, socially and physically rewarding. It is also about having more fun. More than 24 million people have participated nationwide.
